

MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

OF NO CONTRAINDICATION

TO THE PRACTICE OF RUNNING

According to the French laws (articles L. 231-2 & L. 231-3 Code of Sport), a Medical Certificate is required for all runners entering any official competition played in France including Paris-Versailles.

We draw your attention to this important rule in the conditions of register. This measure is to be used in all sports and by all competitions' organizers who can be recognized as responsible.

Therefore Paris-Versailles Association must receive from all registered runners the medical certificate duly filled by a doctor of medicine <u>even if you are well</u> insured when you travel abroad and if a medical assistance covers all expenses.

We know that some countries do not issue such certificates to their runners. Therefore, you will find hereunder a form-sheet "medical certificate already personalized" to know what information needs to be on it.

All runners need to fill in this medical certificate and attach it to their entry form on the www.parisversailles.com website.

The entry form won't be accepted if the certificate isn't filled by a Doctor of Medicine and attached to the corresponding registration.

We hope you understand our position according the French law and are very happy to receive you in Paris-Versailles, la Grande Classique.
